
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Inflation in Germany before the pandemic

Inflation in Germany during the pandemic



Measures taken by the Federal Government to relieve the burden on the population

• From spring 2020 to summer 2022, the German government approved grants, so-called Corona aid, loans, guarantees, etc. totaling 130 billion euros.
